### Ebrahim races to 120km ride victory

HOOD Ebrahim, riding Samir Ibn Sarid, raced to an impressive victory in the season-opening 120-kilometre ride of the Bahrain Royal Equestrian and Endurance Federation (Breef).

The grueling five-stage event was held at the Bahrain International Endurance Village in Sakhir, and it was held under the patronage of Supreme Council for Youth and Sports chairman and Bahrain Olympic Committee president Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa.

Ebrahim claimed his victory in a total ride time of five hours five minutes and 28 seconds.

He managed to stave off the challenges of Shaikh Mohammed bin Mubarak Al Khalifa on Tarabic Carl. Shaikh Mohammed finished the race just a second behind Ebrahim to make for an exciting conclusion.

Fahad Sulaiman Alazri on Mirbat Rosebud was third in 5:09:00.

The first two stages of yesterday's race were over 30km apiece, while the last three were 20km each.

Breef president Shaikh Faisal bin Rashid Al Khalifa flagged off the participants.

Yesterday's race was the first of eight endurance events this season.

It will be followed by a National Day Championship on December 14. The Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa Championship will then be the first race of the new year on January 11.

His Majesty the King's Endurance Championship will then take place on February 8, after which a qualifying race is scheduled for February 22.

The Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa endurance ride will then take place on March 18; followed on April 4 by His Royal Highness the Crown Prince's Endurance Championship.
